Our 2025 budget is \$246,541 and so far our giving is \$118,271. This is where we should of been half way through the year not three quarters through the year. Next month in October we will be discussing the 2026 budget and the news is we will have to make significant cuts to our plans for all areas of our budget. We help many organizations in Claymont and surrounding areas and, unfortunately, we will have to curtail some of this support. Some of the programs at our church wii have to be curtailed if we can not reach our financial goals. This is a topic that I don't like to shout about but this needs to be discussed. 
